

Official Minutes of the Rowlett Arts and Humanities Commission

- 1) Meeting called to order by Chair Jeff Winget at 6:32 p.m. and determined a quorum was present.

- a) Sculpture maintenance
 - Discussed having Boy Scouts and Lions Club members clean sculptures, maybe on a rotating basis.
 Tamra W. will ask interested Lions Club members to complete a Volunteer Application form; Jeff W. will communicate with Scout troop and report back at next meeting.

 - Jim K. reported delays due to weather; will be using an epoxy-based paint once the weather clears. Jim K. estimates sculpture completion by end of February.

 - Jeff W. reported that ideas will be shared at the March meeting; brain-storming activities included:
 - o ideas drawn from Rockwall County courthouse
 - o pieces at each end of Veterans' Park which could be moved in the future, if necessary
 - o inexpensive bronze sculptures imported from China
 - creation of a sculpture park at location/s like Downtown, Waterview, Golf course, Animal Shelter, etc.
 - research into City of Keller's public art program
 - partnering with Keep Rowlett Beautiful to create artwork from materials collected during clean-up day
