4. Presentation on "Scarecrows on Main" project and Rowlett City Academy (Elise Bowers).

- Elise B. presented a "Scarecrows on Main" slideshow; project offers displays to "showcase your story in straw."
- Scarecrows will be displayed on the Village green; build start date is October 5 and scarecrows will be
 displayed until the weekend after Halloween. Will require that someone from Board to check their display
 daily and make repairs as needed. Also, would need a sign with Board's name for the display.

 Library and Archives Commission; accreditation enables eligibility for grants and subsidies, including
 reduced cost for TexShare databases, also participation in statewide interlibrary loan program for our
 customers.
- City using Rene-Bates Auctioneer for online posting and sale to the public of surplus items remaining at the former library location (shelving, tables and chairs, etc.)
- Friends of the Rowlett Library plan to sell Donor Tiles; they are currently working on how to mount tiles in library entrance. Friends are also planning a library grand re-opening event on Saturday, October 13.
- Arts and Humanities Commission dedication of the "Spirit of Rowlett" sculpture at Schrade Bluebonnet Park
 on Saturday, August 25; winners from the Summer Scribes Writing Contest and Photography Contest will be
 presented during the City Council meeting on September 18.
- Plans in the works to relocate and install Mark Twain sculpture at new library location.
