1. Brent Dorenbecker, Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:00am.
2. Quorum present.
3. Review and discuss a sand bunker renovation plan for Waterview Golf Course.
 - A. Members met with Todd Clark, CE Golf Design, to review a revised Preliminary Sand Bunker Renovation Plan. Members discussed each of the eighteen holes at Waterview, the existing sand bunker layout and the potential changes to the layout. Todd was able to provide the team a digital base map and the team virtually visited each hole to look at the existing bunker plan and make recommendations for changes. Todd Clark provided an explanation and how to make this course to be a better community golf course. It was mentioned that angular sand drains well and with smaller bunkers there can be more hand raking which helps the sand to last longer.
 - B. Brad Marshall exited the meeting. Brent Dorenbecker appointed Jeff Feyerherm as a voting member. Jerry Daniels made a motion to accept the design plan including the type of sand and the liners with six recommended changes (holes #2 keep the right-hand back bunker but angle and drop elevation; #4 Make the front left kidney bunker longer; #11 Either add back the bunker on the left-hand side of the fairway or move the bunker to the right-hand side of the fairway in the same general area; #15 Shift the two bunkers in front of the hole to the left and add a bunker in front of the green; Driving Range - add practice bunker to the right or add back the bunker to left but reduce the size; Chipping Green - Increase the size of the bunker). Jeff Feyerherm seconded the motion. Approved 5 to 0.
 - C. Angela Smith stated this plan will be presented to American Golf and to City Council. Todd Clark will be on site during the renovation to oversee and make sure the design is being done correctly. A digital plan will be sent next week, and members were asked to keep the plan confidential.
