AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS, BY AMENDING DIVISION 6 (“SKATE PARK”) OF ARTICLE II (“RULES AND REGULATIONS”) OF CHAPTER 42 (“PARKS AND RECREATION”) TO REVISE REGULATIONS FOR SKATE PARKS; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rowlett, Texas, hereby finds and determines that ordinances should be kept in line with day-to-day operations and that it is important to keep up with industry trends; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that existing regulations relating to skate parks should be revised to enable and promote the promulgation of rules by City staff , as is commonly done for parks and other City recreational facilities;, and that revisions to the City’s skate park regulations are in the best interest of the citizens of the City and are needed to preserve and protect the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That Division 6 (“Skate Park”) of Article II (“Rules and Regulations”) of Chapter 42 (“Parks and Recreation”) of the Code of Ordinances, City of Rowlett, Texas, be and is hereby repealed and replaced with a new Division 6, replacing section 42-181 and repealing sections 42-182 and 42-183, such that Division 6 of Article II of Chapter 42 shall henceforth read in its entirety as follows:

“CHAPTER 42

PARKS AND RECREATION

...

ARTICLE II.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

...

DIVISION 6. SKATE PARK

Sec. 42-181. Rules.

The City Manager or designee shall adopt rules and regulations regarding the operations, usage and fees for city-owned or operated skate parks.”

SECTION 2: That all ordinances of the City of Rowlett in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: That if any section, paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or any other provision of the ordinances of the City of Rowlett.

SECTION 4: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and charter in such cases provide.

At a meeting of the City Council on September 4, 2018 this Ordinance be adopted. The motion carried by the following vote:
