

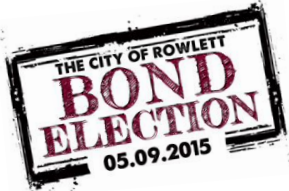
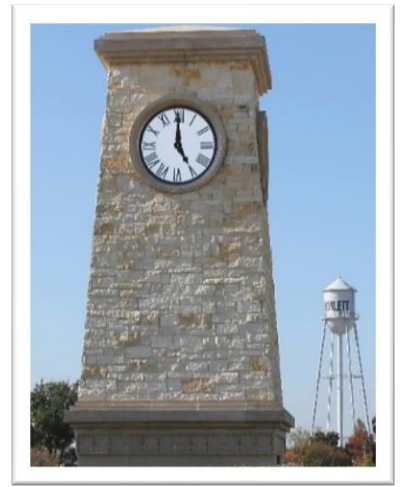

COMMUNITY INVESTMENT PROGRAM (CIP) PROJECT UPDATE

Lake Country Estates Reconstruction Project – Phase 1

Project Scope:

Rebuilding of the streets, sidewalks, curbs, drainage systems, street trees and lighting on Llano St., Southridge Dr., Westview Dr. and west Lynnwood Dr.

Project Status:

The Contractor completed a concrete pour in the westbound lane of Llano Street from Southridge Drive to Aspen Drive. The sidewalk crew was scheduled to pour the sidewalk on north side of Llano Street from Skyline Drive to Herfurth Park however, the concrete pour was cancelled due to rain.

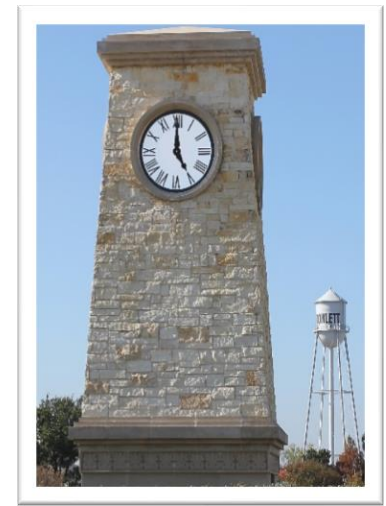

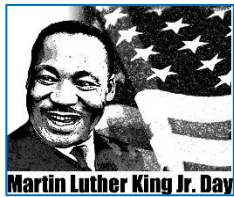
CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE

CONCRETE PANEL REPLACEMENT

Cam-Crete Contracting, INC. will be working on concrete panel replacements and road work on Covington Drive from Dexham Road to Columbus Drive. Construction on this project is scheduled to begin on Monday, January 7th at 9am and will be on going for the next couple of months until panel replacements are completed, pending inclement weather delays. There will be lane closures while work is being completed, but we do not anticipate there being any major delays for the duration of this project. The intersection at Kittyhawk Drive and Covington will be closed for a few weeks, however there will be detours for residents and emergency personnel.
