# Guidelines

**Contest runs from Thursday, January 2 – Friday, January 24.**

Design your own original bookmark celebrating Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Feature a person, invention, or event with historical significance. Have your design displayed at and used by Rowlett Public Library!

Bookmarks judged on **originality, design, and reproducibility.**

Original entries only- no tracing or use of copyrighted images, such as cartoon characters.

Created solely by the eligible contestant – no adult contributions.

## Eligibility

All children in grades K – 12.

Children who attend home school or who attend a school without grade levels should enter the comparable grade level.

**All entries must be clear and reproducible.**

If you include words, check for correct spelling and that writing is clear and fits the space well.

When using marking pens, avoid fluorescent or neon colors.

For crayons and colored pencils, make sure the colors are filled in and solid. Sketching does not reproduce well.

No computer generated art.

Use this entry form or an exact photocopy of the exact size.
