Guidelines

Contest runs from Monday, January 3– Friday, January 21.

Design your own original bookmark celebrating Black History Month. Feature a person, invention, or event with historical significance. Have your design displayed at and used by Rowlett Public Library!

Bookmarks judged on **originality**, **design**, and **reproducibility**.

Original entries only- no tracing or use of copyrighted images, such as cartoon characters.

All entries must be clear and reproducible.

If you include words, check for correct spelling and that writing is clear and fits the space well.

When using marking pens, avoid fluorescent or neon colors.

For crayons and colored pencils, make sure the colors are filled in and solid. Sketching does not reproduce well.

No digital photography. Use of a drawing software is permitted (e.g., Corel Draw, Illustrator, Procreate).

Use this entry form or an exact photocopy of the exact size (1.5" x 8.5").

All entries must be physically printed in order to qualify.
