Lynda Humble Resigns as City Manager

CITY OF ROWLETT, TX – The City Council and Lynda Humble reached an agreement at last night’s Special City Council Meeting to accept her resignation as City Manager effective immediately.

“We appreciate Lynda’s service to this organization during her 4 ½ year tenure as Rowlett’s City Manager,” says Mayor Todd W. Gottel. “Lynda led transformational change for the City of Rowlett that included fiscally conservative financial stewardship with declining property values, while maintaining or improving service levels with a strong commitment to exceptional customer service. She also ensured that Rowlett citizens were encouraged to participate in their local government through programs such as *Rowlett. My Community. My Money. My Choice.*, where after being educated, 77% of the participants agreed to consider a raise in taxes to keep existing programs and services. She has left an indelible mark on this community through her commitment to encouraging volunteerism, nearly tripling participation during her tenure and saving taxpayers over \$1.7 million. Lynda also ensured that our organization advocated for Rowlett citizens during the construction of DART & PGBT to keep the disturbance to this community to a minimum.”
